St. Lawrence debuted the alloy-engined version of his Michelob Mercedes -- giving it a 380SL nameplate -- in bittersweet fashion. He qualified 10th and, on lap 26, had passed T. Brassfield for what was then third and began to gain on Bundy. But a blown engine dropped oil on SIR's tricky turn 3, sending quite a few cars spinning wildly, including Lindley. The Michelob car spun too, hitting the Camaro's solid door bars with the Mercedes' not-quite-so-solid nose, ripping out various vital pieces.

Hurley Haywood qualified his Bayside Disposal Porsche sixth and had worked his way back up to fifth when his engine gave out. Wayne Harper made his best showing by running as high as fifth before retiring his Techniquip Corvette. Young Karl Durkheimer put on an excellent show, in his V. Polak Porsche 911SC, mechanical problems taking him out of sixth place seven laps from the end.

The CRC Trans-Am circus now moves east with a July 18 show at Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course and a July 24 race at Road America before a week's rest and then August 8 at Brainerd International Raceway.
